## Market Overview

Goldman Sachs Dynamic Opportunities ("GSDO" or the "Fund") ended the month of July in negative territory after what has been acknowledged to be one of the most challenging environments for hedge funds broadly. Seven of the twenty managers in the portfolio generated positive returns during the month.

Two of the eight managers in event driven sector positively contributed to performance. Generally, managers were hurt by long exposure to commodity/energy related equities, which fell on the back of meaningful declines in oil and natural gas prices. In addition, a significant rally in the financial sector hurt managers who held short positions in the sector. In general, managers continue to selectively add risk to the merger arbitrage space. Leveraged loan and high yield bond spreads widened on concerns over corporate earnings and weakness in the U.S. economy. While managers continue to selectively add exposure, especially in the senior parts of the capital structure, they remain cautious about the overall environment.

Two of the three tactical trading managers ended the month positively despite the sharp market reversals. Long commodity exposure, particularly in energy and agricultural markets, detracted from performance. In equities, managers were hurt by their short financials positions and long exposure to commodity-producing countries. In FX, the strengthening of the U.S. dollar led to moderate losses. Fixed income trading globally led to mixed results.

Three of the eight equity long/short managers in this sector ended the month positive. Global equity markets had an extremely volatile month characterized by a sharp second half rally in the financials sector and steep losses among energy and materials stocks, resulting in a wide dispersion of returns among managers. Largest losses stemmed from long positions in energy and materials stocks, short positions in the financials and real estate sectors and long exposure to emerging markets. Notable positive contributions came from long exposure to small cap equities and financials, as well as idiosyncratic security selection. Better performing managers tended to have balanced net exposures across a number of market sectors and geographies.

In line with the Investment Manager's active management of the portfolio, with effect from 30 June 2008, GSDO redeemed its remaining investments with relative value managers (where the Investment Manager expects there to be less opportunities in the short to medium term) and invested with one event driven and one equity long/short manager.

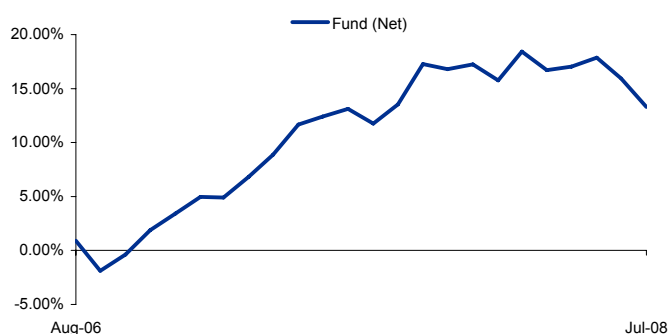

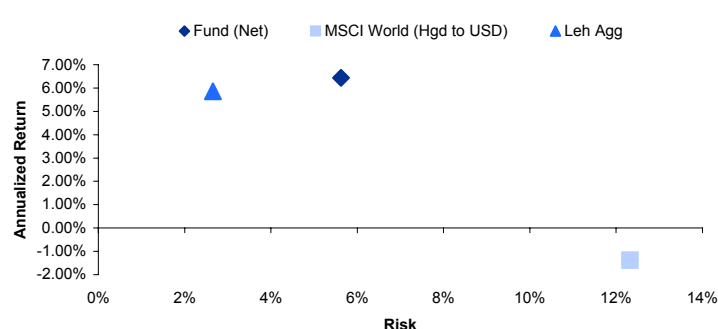

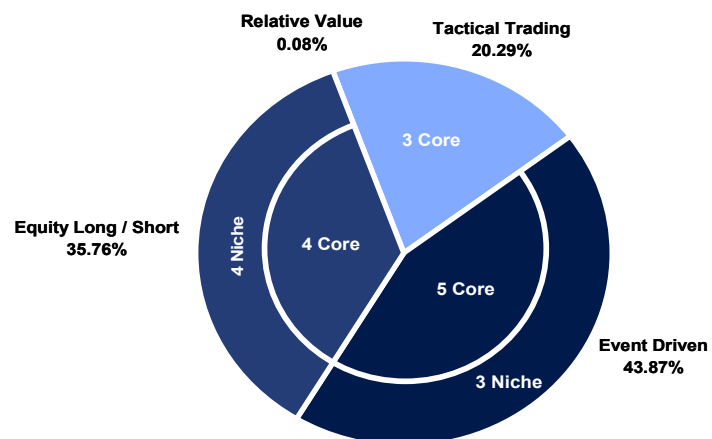

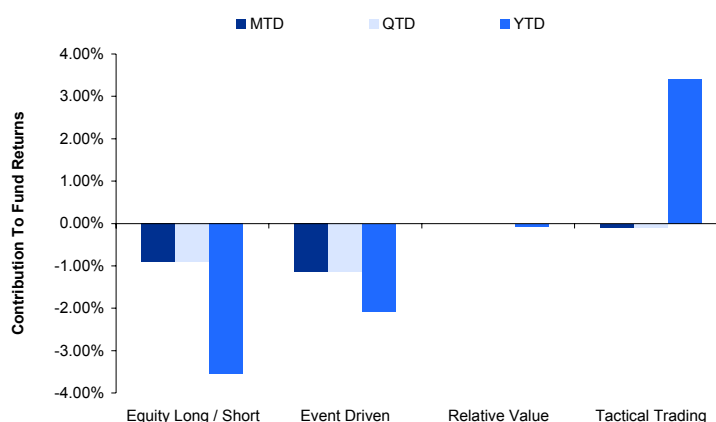

Effect of fees on performance:

The following table provides a simplified example of the effect of management and incentive fees on portfolio returns. For example, assume a portfolio has a steady investment return, gross of fees, of 0.5% per month and total management fees of 0.1250% per month of the market value of the portfolio on the last day of the month and incentive fees of 10% of net profits. Management fees and incentive fees are deducted from the market value of the portfolio on that day. There are no cash flows during the period. The table shows that, assuming that other factors such as investment return and fees remain constant, the difference increases due to the compounding effect over time. Of course, the magnitude of the difference between gross-of-fee and net-of-fee returns will depend on a variety of factors, and the example has been intentionally simplified.
