

# Community TeamWorks

## TEN YEAR IMPACT SUMMARY

Every year since 1997, in partnership with 833 nonprofit community partners worldwide, Goldman Sachs people along with their family and friends have given a day to give back to the communities where we work and live. To date, we have had 143,605 volunteer participants in 9,427 projects. We assisted 250,100 youth, 112,248 adults, 32,519 elderly, 224,446 persons with disabilities/special needs and 23,995 animals; painted 159 murals; renovated and helped build 1,442 community buildings/homes and 107 playgrounds; beautified 59 beaches; planted 822 gardens and 126,811 trees and flowers; delivered and served 98,451 meals; packaged 1,850,135 lbs. of food; beautified 8,993 acres of land.



**ATLANTA** Assisted 475 youth, 320 adults, and 140 persons with disabilities/special needs; renovated and helped build 3 community buildings/homes and 1 playground; delivered and served 50 meals.

**BANGALORE** Assisted 968 youth, 76 adults 146 elderly; 180 persons with disabilities/special needs and 75 animals; painted 4 murals; renovated and helped build 12 community buildings/homes and 4 playgrounds; planted 2 gardens and 605 trees and flowers; delivered and served 358 meals.
